Dear Neighbor,

The Orange County Water District (OCWD; the District) manages the groundwater basin underlying north and central Orange County that provides 77% of the water supply to 2.5 million people. It owns and operates monitoring wells throughout the region, which measure groundwater levels and allow for the collection of water samples. The wells provide the District with valuable data to assess aquifer levels and to maintain a high-quality water supply.

OCWD will soon begin construction on a series of three monitoring wells on Oriole Circle (see map on reverse for project site labeled OCWD M58). Construction is anticipated to begin on or about November 16, 2020 and last approximately three weeks. Anticipated construction hours are Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. – 5 p.m. with no work on holidays. OCWD is committed to completing this project as quickly as possible. However, this timeframe could change due to inclement weather or other unforeseen circumstances.

OCWD's construction management team will closely monitor construction activities to minimize impacts to the community as much as possible. However, you may notice an increase in noise, dust and construction equipment. Temporary sound walls will be installed to reduce noise. There will be no street parking within the construction area. OCWD has obtained all necessary permits and approvals for this project and is complying with applicable ordinances. For your safety, please keep away from construction equipment and obey all local laws and ordinances.

Thank you for your patience as OCWD works to ensure a continued safe and reliable water supply.
