The Orange County Water District (OCWD) is a global leader in groundwater management and water reuse. Consolidation of OCWD and the Municipal Water District of Orange County (MWDOC) has been routinely discussed in the Orange County water community for decades. Three times, an Orange County Grand Jury formally reviewed the operations of OCWD and MWDOC; each time concluding the agencies should consolidate for the benefit of Orange County's ratepayers. The Orange County LAFCO is currently studying this issue but requires legislation amending the OCWD Act before it will formally consider consolidation.

A singular organization would be able to maximize the coordination between providing groundwater, reclaimed water and imported water; improving the overall water supply reliability of the region. Now is the time to come together with one voice to address the challenges facing the water community today, and collaborate to ensure a reliable water supply for generations to come.
