

South Basin RI/FS: Agreements with DTSC and RWQCB

OCWD is conducting a RI/FS for South Basin in compliance with the National Contingency Plan (NCP).

- Remedial Investigation (RI)
 - Characterize nature and extent of contamination
 - Construct monitoring wells
 - Prepare report
- Feasibility Study (FS)
 - Evaluate remedial alternatives
- Proposed Plan – preferred remedial alternative

Staff recommends involving state regulatory agencies to provide input on OCWD's RI/FS.

- Review and comment on RI/FS documents
- Coordinate OCWD's off-site remedial focus with on-site source area remediation
- Exchange data
- Coordinate public outreach

Purpose of agreements with DTSC and RWQCB:

Reimburse agencies for staff time to:

- Review and comment on OCWD RI/FS documents
- Attend coordination meetings
- Conduct internal communications
- Conduct site visits

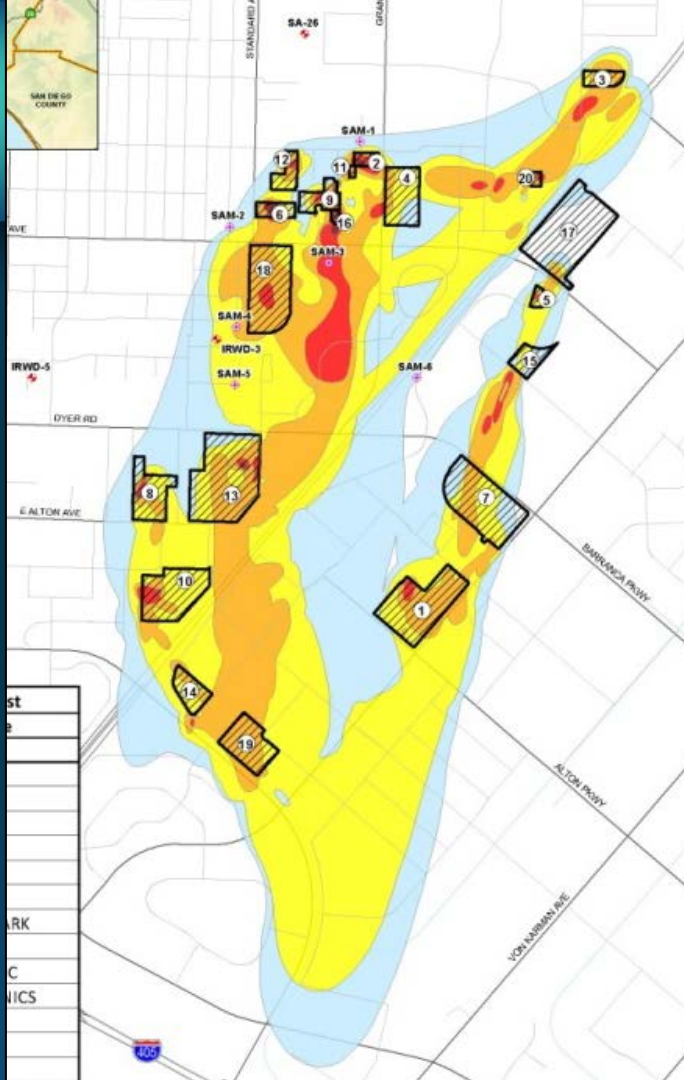


Agreement Details:

- Costs based on time spent and staff billing rates
- 18-month duration; may be extended or terminated
- No non-performance penalty provisions

Staff Recommendations:

1. Authorize GM to finalize and execute agreement with DTSC for reimbursement of costs in an amount not to exceed \$75,000 to review documents submitted by the District as part of the South Basin RI/FS program; and
2. Authorize execution of agreement with RWQCB for reimbursement of costs in an amount not to exceed \$120,000 to review documents submitted by the District as part of the South Basin RI/FS program.



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
