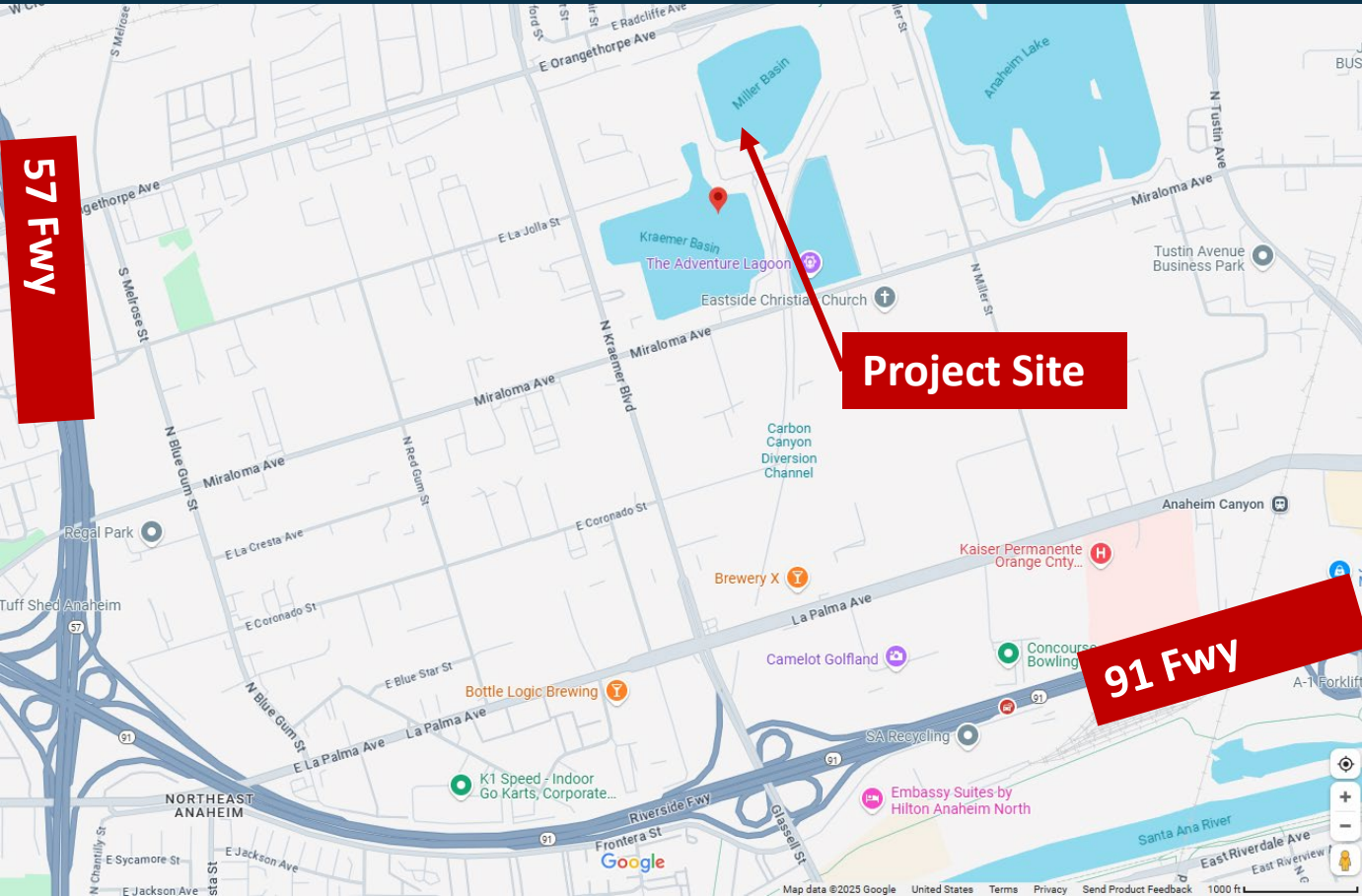

- Check valves are part of a submerged pump station in a groundwater recharge basin (lake)
- Recharges river, imported, and recycled water
- Submerged 50-75% of the year

- Street access from Miraloma Ave
- Perimeter road
- Joint use of street access and perimeter road
- 2 ramps to floor
- Ramps & floor are loose sand
- May be standing water adjacent to work area



- Basin typically dry before July
- Suggested that Contractor order materials early and perform on-site work between July and mid-October
- Site may be dry and available before July



- Standing water at valves will be removed by OCWD prior to contractor work.

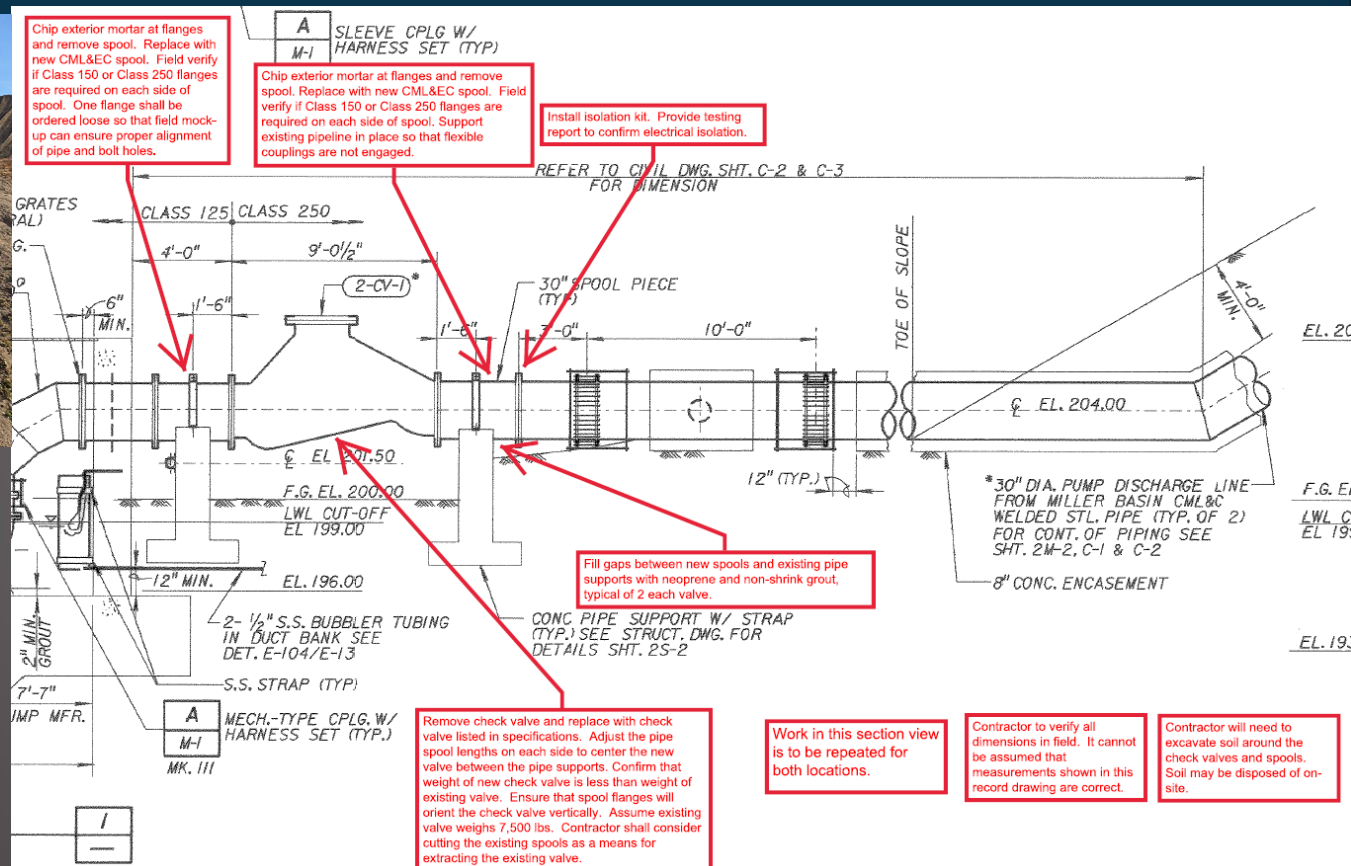


Standing water on opposite side of concrete sump may be present.
