ORANGE COUNTY WATER DISTRICT TO SERVE AS FOUR-DAY VOTE CENTER

FOUNTAIN VALLEY, Calif. (Feb. 28, 2020) – The Orange County Water District (OCWD; the District) will serve as a four-day Vote Center for the 2020 primary election from Saturday, Feb. 29 through Tuesday, March 3. OCWD is one of three Vote Centers in Fountain Valley; there are a total of 189 throughout the county.

“The District is proud to serve as an Orange County Vote Center during the program’s inaugural year,” said OCWD President Vicente Sarmiento. “The right to vote is a pillar of our country’s democracy, and OCWD looks forward to providing a location for residents to cast their ballots and take part in the political process.”

OCWD Vote Center hours are from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. Saturday, Sunday and Monday, and from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m. Tuesday. OCWD is located at 18700 Ward Street, Fountain Valley.
